A hole which has never been played yet is destined to be a classic when it opens in 2024, A superb downhill and a downwind drivable par 4 designed by English architect Stuart Hallett, It's a hole which tempts you to hit the driver, but trouble awaits. The hole is timed at the right point of the round to tempt, whether playing strokeplay or matchplay. The green is a masterpiece, falling away from the golfer and built just at the right level to give views to the surrounding landscape.
